Senior Rate up to 320 lbs.	\$ <b>15.20</b>
<b>Yard Debris</b>	
Minimum up to 860 lbs.	\$ <b>24.70</b>
Over 860 lbs.	\$ <b>59.00/ton</b>
<b>Unsecured Load*</b>	\$ 19.00

#### SPECIAL HANDLING FEE

**\$ 80.00 Boat/RV/Junk vehicle disposal**

(this fee is in addition to the disposal rate and charges for Freon or for emptying tanks)

#### RECYCLING:

##### Commodity

<b>Antifreeze</b>	\$1.65/gallon (in leak-proof container) **
<b>Automotive Batteries</b>	\$2.70/each (no broken or leaking batteries) **
<b>Fluorescent Tubes</b>	\$0.20/ft. **
<b>Paint (Latex, Oil, Acrylic, Stains)</b>	Free (in containers of 5 gallons or less) ***
<b>Medical Sharps</b>	Free in certified containers. Medical Sharps are accepted for disposal during normal operations provided they are dropped off in certified containers. Certified containers are available at <b>no cost</b> at the Transfer Station Scale House <b>to Columbia County residents.</b>

**Refrigerant Appliances** \$26.30/each

-Refrigerators, Freezers, A/C units

##### **Tires:**

- Passenger Car off-rim \$5.20/each
- Passenger Car on-rim \$10.50/each
- Semi/Tractor off-rim \$15.70/each
- Semi/Tractor on-rim \$26.20/each
- Bicycle, motorcycle and solid core tires are accepted as garbage at the garbage rate.

**Used Motor Oil** Free (placed in leak proof containers)

**Used Oil Filters** \$1.15/each (drained, bagged & placed with used motor oil)
